While serving as European Sales Manager for Wilson in Germany, he was able to fulfill his dream of playing professional basketball by signing a contract with the Ford Motor Co. Team in Antwerp, Belgium. Basketball became his lifelong passion, which included winning three gold medals for Team USA in the Senior Olympics.
