City Councilmember Kirk Mikulec was first elected to Place 1 on The Colony City Council in 2012, and was re-elected November 2015. Councilmember Mikulec is a member of the city outreach committee to Lewisville ISD, and is the council liaison to the city's Library Board. He previously served on the FM 423 Task Force.
