Subject: Auto/Pedestrian Fatality Accident 4800 Blk S.H. 121

At approximately 4:00 p.m., The Colony Dispatch Center received 911 calls of a pedestrian being struck by a vehicle in the south bound service road of the 4800 blk of S.H. 121. Police and paramedics were immediately dispatched. The female victim (54 years of age), was transported to Baylor Hospital of Carrollton, where she was pronounced dead shortly after arrival. The driver of the vehicle did stop at the scene and talked to investigators. There were also eye witnesses to this accident who were interviewed by investigators.

The pedestrian was trying to cross the service road where there are no traffic lights or crosswalks. At this point, it is believed that neither alcohol nor speeding were contributing factors to this accident. No criminal charges are anticipated at this time. The service road was temporarily shut down, but is now open.

The names of the driver and victim are being withheld, pending notification of the victim's next of kin. At the time of this release, the investigation is still underway.
