Police respond to aggravated robbery

THE COLONY, Texas — At around 12:30 p.m. Monday, July 22, The Colony Police Department responded to a report of a theft of an expensive watch in the 5800 block of Spring Hollow Lane.

An investigation revealed that the complainant, who lives on Spring Hollow Lane, had advertised a watch on Craig's List. According to the complainant, the watch was worth \$7,000. An individual, responding to the ad for the watch, arrived at the complainant's home at around 12:25 p.m.; that individual was accompanied by another male. The individual was given the watch to inspect at which time the complainant noticed that he was hiding a dark-colored handgun under a towel.

The complainant backed up and the individual fled with the other male in a 2009 Silver Mercury Grand Marquis. It was discovered later that the suspect vehicle had been reported stolen to the Mansfield Police Department.

The Colony police encountered the suspect vehicle in the 4800 block of Main Street. When officers attempted to stop the vehicle, it fled. Officer pursued the vehicle to SH121 and I-35E but the on-duty supervisor terminated the pursuit because of traffic conditions and speeds above 100 mph.

The suspect vehicle was last seen heading south on I-35E from 121. The investigation continues.
