Early voting begins Monday; IDs required

THE COLONY, Texas — Early voting by personal appearance for the Nov. 4, 2014, City of The Colony City Council Election begins on Monday, Oct. 20, and continues through Friday, Oct. 31.

In The Colony, voting will be held at the Denton County Government Center, 6301 Main St., the following dates and times:

- 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, Oct. 20-24;
- 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 25;
- 1 to 6 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 26; and,
- 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday, Oct. 27-31.

Voters may also vote at any Denton County early voting location. The full list of early voting locations and other election information can be found on the city's website at:

Voters are reminded that to cast a ballot in person, a registered voter needs to present one of the following approved forms of photo ID:

- Texas Driver License – issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS);
- Texas Personal Identification Card – issued by DPS;
- Texas Concealed Handgun License – issued by DPS;
- United States Military Identification card containing the person's photograph;
- United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph;
- United States Passport – issued by the U.S. government; or,
- Election Identification Certificate – issued free by DPS

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the photo ID must be current or expired no more than 60 days. For more election information, please contact the City Secretary at 972-624-3106 or visit the city website at www.thecolonytx.gov.
