## **Main Street lane closures**

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of an effort to keep residents informed, officials with the City of The Colony are in continuous contact with representatives from the Texas Department of Transportation regarding the progress of the Main Street Widening Project.

Current or upcoming lane closures are listed below. **All closures are limited to 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Two lanes in both directions will remain open during peak times and weekends when at all possible.** As always, motorists are advised to prepare for delays and seek alternate routes where possible.

### **Lane Closures**

The following closures are scheduled for Monday, Feb. 9, through Monday, Feb. 23:

- full closure of Ridgepointe Drive at the intersection of Ridgepointe and FM 423 for excavation, installation of a box culvert, and restoration of the roadway.

The following closure is scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 21:

- northbound left lane and southbound left turn lane to Cougar Alley on FM 423 from Memorial Drive to Friendship Lane for excavation, installation of a box culvert, and restoration of the roadway.

The following closures are scheduled for Monday, Feb. 23, through Friday, Feb. 27:

- left lane closure of eastbound and/or westbound Memorial Drive at the intersection with FM 423 for asphalt work.
- left lane closure of eastbound and/or westbound South Colony Boulevard at the intersection with FM 423 for asphalt work.
- alternate lane closures in the various lanes of eastbound and/or westbound North Colony Boulevard at the intersection with FM 423 for asphalt work.
- alternate lane closures in the various lanes of northbound and southbound FM 423 from State Highway 121 to Stewarts Creek Road for restriping and traffic switch.

The following closure is scheduled for Monday, March 9, through Saturday, March 14:

- full closure of Cougar Alley at the intersection of Cougar Alley and FM 423 for excavation, installation of a water line.
