## **Flood recovery update**

THE COLONY, Texas — The City of The Colony is in the flood recovery phase waiting for the water to recede on Lewisville Lake so we may begin preliminary damage assessments of the parks and other infrastructures. According to the US Army Corps of Engineers, the lake is currently at 536.20 feet and continues to slowly recede.

Denton County has been listed in the State's Disaster Declaration along with 69 other counties. On May 29, the President approved the Major Disaster Declaration (DR-4223). Federal funding is available for the affected individuals in Harris, Hays, and Van Zandt counties. Additional counties may be added to the declaration as the situation develops. Individuals and business who may have been affected by the severe storms and flooding starting on May 4 should contact their insurance provider and continue to track expenses related to this event.
