## **Main Street traffic switch at North Colony**

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of an effort to keep residents informed, officials with the City of The Colony are in continuous contact with representatives from the Texas Department of Transportation regarding the progress of the Main Street Widening Project.

In addition to lane closures, we feel it important to provide residents with notices of traffic switches because lanes may be configured differently than the last time you drove them. Motorists are encouraged to focus on the roadway in order to avoid accidents from being in the wrong lane.

### **Traffic Switch**

**The following roadwork is scheduled for 9 p.m. Wednesday, July 8 to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 9:**

- traffic switch on Main Street – restoration of left-turn lanes from both northbound and southbound Main Street onto North Colony Boulevard. Various lanes, both northbound and southbound FM 423, from Carr Street to Nash Drive will be closed. This work was originally scheduled for June but was delayed due to weather.
