Indictment handed down to Rapido robbery/murder suspect

THE COLONY, Texas — On Thursday, Sept. 10, a Denton County Grand Jury handed down a “True Bill” indictment against Deon Kingston Jr. for the Aggravated Robbery and Murder at Rapido Convenience Store, meaning he will stand trial.

Mrs. Samaria Siwakoti was shot and killed inside Rapido on June 10, 2015, when Kingston pulled out a gun and shot her while stealing money from the cash register. Kingston fled the area after committing the crime.

On June 19, Kingston was officially charged with Capital Murder for that crime after The Colony Police Department detectives, whom had worked around the clock, were able to link Kingston to the murder.

The case was presented to a Denton County Grand Jury exactly three months after the murder. The case is still open and additional evidence is pending.
