Major utility expansion project kicks off Jan. 4

THE COLONY, Texas — The City of The Colony is excited to announce that the expansion project for the Stewart Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant is scheduled to begin Jan. 4, 2016.

This project was approved by The Colony City Council on Nov. 17 when it awarded a construction services contract to Pepper-Lawson in the amount of \$17.8 million. The project is expected to be completed by September 2017, and will be directly overseen by the city's engineering consultants who designed the new plant. The construction work is expected to have very minimal effect, if any, on residents of The Colony.



With a current operating capacity of 3.39 million gallons per day (mgd) and a daily average flow of 2.9mgd, improvements were needed to meet both TCEQ requirements and the demands of an ever-growing city.
