Roberts Drive reconstruction to begin Jan. 22

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of the city's Phase V Street Reconstruction project for the 2015-16 budget year, roadwork on Roberts Drive will begin Friday, Jan. 22.

The westbound lane will be under construction first. Starting Friday, Roberts Drive will be one-way eastbound from Blair Oaks Drive to John Yates Drive because of school bus loading and unloading. There will be no parking on the street at any time. One lane will be opened for emergency vehicles and thru-traffic. Mailboxes will be moved from one side of the road to the other during construction.

Phase V Reconstruction, scheduled for June 2015 to July 2016, consists of three projects: Nash Drive from John Yates Drive to Paige Road; Ragan Road from North Colony to Ragan Place; and Roberts Drive from Blair Oaks Drive to John Yates Drive. These residential streets are being reconstructed with reinforced concrete pavement to the same width as the existing roadways. Sidewalk and driveway returns within street right-of-ways will also be reconstructed, as well as storm drains, water and wastewater mains, and street lights. Total cost of the Phase V project is \$3.2 million.
