Free mulch available year-round

THE COLONY, Texas — Residents are accustomed to the annual availability of free mulch in January resulting from the city’s Christmas-tree recycling program. But with the start of the latest contract with the city’s solid waste services provider, free mulch will now be available all year round.

The mulch site is at the south end of the Public Services parking lot off of East Lake Highlands Drive, across from the Animal Shelter. Signs are posted directing residents to the site. Mulch is available first-come, first-served. Please bring your own containers. The site will be replenished with mulch on a periodic basis.

As for tree recycling, the city is no longer accepting trees at the location. However, residents who still require disposal may leave their trees curbside or in the alley (depending on usual collection routine) on their scheduled green/bulk waste collection days or contact the city about obtaining a permit for nearby landfills.
