Main Street traffic switches: Feb. 19 and 26

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of an effort to keep residents informed, officials with the City of The Colony are in continuous contact with representatives from the Texas Department of Transportation regarding the progress of the Main Street Widening Project.

In addition to lane closures, we feel it important to provide residents with notices of traffic switches because lanes may be configured differently than the last time you drove them. Motorists are encouraged to focus on the roadway in order to avoid accidents from being in the wrong lane.

Traffic Switches

The following roadwork is scheduled for 6 p.m. Friday, Feb. 19, to 8 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 20:

- shift of northbound lanes of Main Street between Overlake Drive and Stewarts Creek Road to the east, resulting in northbound traffic travelling on newly paved road across the bridge on Lewisville Lake. *Traffic will be one lane each direction during the shift.* Click [here](#) for a schematic of the switch.

The following roadwork is scheduled for 6 p.m. Friday, Feb. 26, to 7 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 27:

- shift of southbound lanes of Main Street between Overlake Drive and Stewarts Creek Road to the east, resulting in both north- and southbound traffic travelling on newly paved road across the bridge on Lewisville Lake. Traffic will be one lane each direction during the shift. Click [here](#) for a schematic of the switch. – **UPDATE: This switch has been postponed.**
