## **Main Street traffic switch: July 12**

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of an effort to keep residents informed, officials with the City of The Colony are in continuous contact with representatives from the Texas Department of Transportation regarding the progress of the Main Street Widening Project.

In addition to lane closures, we feel it important to provide residents with notices of traffic switches because lanes may be configured differently than the last time you drove them. Motorists are encouraged to focus on the roadway in order to avoid accidents from being in the wrong lane.

### **Traffic Switches**

#### **The following roadwork is scheduled for Tuesday, July 12:**

- both north- and southbound lanes of Main Street between Carr and Oak streets will be shifted to the west onto newly paved road. **Lake Highlands Drive will also be re-opened following the switch.** Motorists are advised to be mindful of new traffic flow and drive with caution in the area.
