Roadway project to impact commute as school year begins

THE COLONY, Texas — Improving and maintaining the city’s transportation infrastructure is an ongoing priority for city leadership, especially in light of unprecedented growth taking place in the community. From side streets to Main Street, there’s no shortage of critical roadway reconstruction projects currently underway in The Colony.

With the start of the new school year on Monday, Aug. 22, there will be a significant increase in the volume of morning and afternoon traffic. Please be advised of the following road conditions and plan accordingly:

- **North Colony at Main Street** – The Texas Department of Transportation and its contractors are working to complete this portion of the Main Street Widening Project as soon as possible. However, completion is still about 30 days away. **With not all lanes yet fully open, motorists should anticipate delays moving through the intersection.** If it all possible, please leave early and budget extra time for your commute.
