Owl & Howl Prowl set for Oct. 27

THE COLONY, Texas — Have you ever been on a guided tour of The Colony Shoreline Trail? Join Keep The Colony Beautiful later this month for a rare chance to stay on the trail after hours and learn about the local wildlife and native plants from a local expert.

Go on a leisurely, guided **“Owl & Howl Prowl” from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 27**, to look for wildlife and their tracks and signs with Texas Master Naturalist and The Colony resident Donna Cole. Listen and learn how to identify sounds from local nocturnal animals. Get educated about the wildlife that lives around and among us and how we can coexist peacefully.



The walk will be approximately 1-2 miles round trip. Bring water and dress for the weather; bug spray and binoculars are optional. Flashlights are highly recommended.
