TCPD executes narcotics search warrant Oct. 15

THE COLONY, Texas — At approximately 8 a.m. Saturday, Oct. 15, The Colony Police Department's Special Response Team, along with the assistance of the Denton County Sheriff's Office, executed a narcotics search warrant on a residence in the 4900 block of Hackney Lane. The search warrant was a result of a lengthy narcotics investigation conducted by the Criminal Investigation Division over a period of several weeks after receiving multiple tips from the community.



Over 50 pounds of liquid methamphetamine along with smaller amounts of crystal methamphetamine, heroin, and marijuana were discovered and seized as a result of the search warrant; a stolen vehicle was also recovered from the property.

Five individuals were inside the residence during the search warrant, three of whom were arrested:

- 58-year-old William Bryant Blum Sr. was arrested and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance/ Penalty Group 1 Analogue and Possession of a Controlled Substance Penalty Group 1 over 1 gram;
- 31-year-old William Bryant Blum Jr. was arrested and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance Penalty Group 1 over 1 gram; and,
- 21-year-old Lacey Michelle Boothe was arrested and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance Penalty Group 1 over 1 gram.

All three suspects were later transported to The Colony Jail. The investigation is still ongoing at the time of this release.
