## **Election Day is Nov. 8; City offices to close early**

THE COLONY, Texas — Election Day is Tuesday, Nov. 8. **Voters must cast their ballots at locations specific to the precinct in which they reside. Polls will be open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**

Election Day precincts and polling locations within The Colony include:

- 2022 – Calvary Christian Center, 5520 Blair Oaks Drive
- 2023 – Morningside Elementary, 6350 Paige Road
- 2024 – Owen Elementary, 5640 Squires Drive
- 2025 – Peters Colony Elementary, 5101 Nash Drive
- 2026 – The Colony Government Center, 6301 Main St.
- 2027 – Lakeview Middle School, 4300 Keys Drive
