## **TCPD conducts DWI ‘No Refusal’ operations**

THE COLONY, TX – The Colony Police Department conducted Driving While Intoxicated No-Refusal operations March 4-21, 2017, by means of a grant from the Texas Department of Transportation.

During the No-Refusal operations, those arrested for DWI are offered a blood test to determine their blood alcohol concentration. A search warrant, authorizing a blood draw, is sought for anyone refusing consent to a blood test.

Officers worked a total of 41 hours during the operational period resulting in 48 traffic stops and five arrests for Driving While Intoxicated.
