Memorial Drive, east of FM 423, closed March 30

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of an effort to keep residents informed, officials with the City of The Colony are in continuous contact with representatives from the Texas Department of Transportation regarding the progress of the Main Street Widening Project.

In order to continue that progress, TxDOT officials have advised the city that there will be a **full closure of Memorial Drive between Blair Oaks and the intersection with FM 423 starting 9 a.m. Thursday, March 30, and continuing through 3:30 p.m. that day.** This closure is necessary for installation of storm drainage.
