Update: Boil-water notice for The Tribute

THE COLONY, Texas — Per the [notice issued July 13](#), the work to install the new waterline at the Wynnwood Pump Station was completed as planned. Following completion of the work, Public Works crews started flushing the system this morning in order to remove possible contaminants and air that may have entered the system during the work performed. They are now in the process of collecting bacteriological samples and will be taking the samples to a lab in order to verify that the system is free of bacterial contamination and safe for consumption.

It is anticipated to receive the test results within 24 hours, at which time an additional notice will be released that informs the affected public of the suspension of the boil water notice. Until the boil water notice is suspended, we encourage all effected customers to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc.).
