## **DWI enforcement grant in the summer**

THE COLONY, TX – The Colony Police Department conducted Driving While Intoxicated No-Refusal operations June 24 to July 6 by means of a grant from the Texas Department of Transportation.

During the No-Refusal operations, those arrested for DWI were offered a blood test to determine their blood-alcohol concentration. A search warrant, authorizing a blood draw, is sought for anyone refusing consent to a blood test.

Officers worked a total of 41 hours during the operational period resulting in 10 traffic stops. We are grateful to report that no arrests were made.
