Main Street lights to be configured, all lanes to open

THE COLONY, Texas — A significant milestone in the [Main Street Widening Project](#) is approaching. Starting Monday, July 31, all lanes of traffic and turn lanes on Main Street from State Highway 121 to the northern city limits are scheduled to be opened.

The only exception will be a closure of the northbound right lane from Hetherington to Nash for ongoing placement of the sound wall. After July 31, only daytime closures (9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.) for specific work will be allowed until the project is completed near the end of the year.

In preparation for the lane openings, however, TxDOT and city staff will be performing final configuration of the traffic lights and cameras beginning the week prior. This includes the traffic light at Lake Highlands Drive, which will go



online starting Monday, July 24. During the past few years, the timings have been configured to account for ongoing construction and lane closures at the primary intersections but will now be configured to maximize efficient traffic flow for the completed roadway.

Motorists are strongly advised to plan for delays in the coming weeks as engineers make the final adjustments to the new traffic light equipment.
